- What difference does it make to see our children and youth as part of our church family now, and not just the "future of our church"?
- Sometimes we have ideas of what it looks like to have children or youth be a part of our church—what boxes, either intentionally or unintentionally do we tend to put them in? What would it look like if we didn't?
- Finally, some of us are gifted and called to work with children or youth, but some of us are not. However, we are still called to make room for them in our lives as a church. What might that mean to you?
